**SAN JOSE MAYOR SAM LICCARDO
Is a Felon!**

June 04, 2016 – **Statement of EDWARD C NOONAN, 2016 Presidential Candidate:**

The **AMERICAN RESISTANCE PARTY** is calling for the arrest of San Jose Mayor Sam Liccardo for violating the California Constitution as violent protesters attacked political rally attendees at a Donald Trump rally on June 2, 2016. The **American Resistance Party** is joining with others who have been sharply critical of San Jose Police for officers' lack of response to protect Trump supporters from anti-Trump demonstrators Thursday night.

The California Constitution states:

ARTICLE 1 DECLARATION OF RIGHTS

SECTION 14. Felonies shall be prosecuted as provided by law...

San Jose Mayor Sam Liccardo is guilty of a Federal crime. Federal Immigration and Nationality Act Section 8 USC 1324(a)(1)(A)(iv)(b)(iii)

"Any person who . . . encourages or induces an alien to . . . reside . . . knowing or in reckless disregard of the fact that such . . . residence is . . . in violation of law, shall be punished as provided . . . for each alien in respect to whom such a violation occurs . . . fined under title 18 . . . imprisoned not more than 5 years, or both."

Section 274 felonies under the federal Immigration and Nationality Act, INA 274A(a)(1)(A):

A person (including a group of persons, business, organization, or **local government**) **commits a federal felony when she or he:**

*** assists an alien s/he should reasonably know is illegally in the U.S.** or who lacks employment authorization, by transporting, sheltering, or assisting him or her to obtain employment, or

*** encourages that alien to remain in the U.S.** by referring him or her to an employer or by acting as employer or agent for an employer in any way, or

*** knowingly assists illegal aliens due to personal convictions.**

Furthermore, San Jose Mayor Sam Liccardo is guilty of violating The Ralph Act:

1)"The Ralph Act," Civil Code sections 51.7 and 52--provides that it is a civil right for a person to be free of violence or its threat against the person or his or her property, because of a person's race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, political affiliation, sex, sexual orientation, age or disability or position in a labor dispute, or because a person is perceived to have one or more of these characteristics--(bases of discrimination are illustrative, rather than restrictive)

Enforced by the Department of Fair Employment and Housing, which prosecutes, and the Fair Employment and Housing Commission, which adjudicates, and by the Attorney General, any district or city attorney and by private attorneys Provides for civil penalties of up to \$25,000 for perpetrators, civil remedies to victims of "hate violence," three times actual damages, but no less than \$1000, punitive damages, injunctive relief and attorney's fees

2) "The Bane Act," Civil Code section 52.1 --provides protection from interference by threats, intimidation, or coercion or for attempts to interfere with someone's state or federal statutory or constitutional rights (these include association, assembly, due process, education, employment, equal protection, expression, formation and enforcement of contracts, holding of public office, housing, privacy, speech, travel, use of public facilities, voting, worship, and protection from bodily restraint or harm, from personal insult, from defamation, and from injury to personal relations)-- proof of "hate motivation" required, according to a 1994 Court of Appeal decision in *Bocato v. City of Hermosa Beach*

Enforced by Attorney General, any district attorney or city attorney, or a private attorney

Provides for civil penalties for perpetrators, civil remedies to victims of "hate violence," three times actual damages, but no less than \$1000, punitive damages, injunctive and other equitable relief (violation of the injunctive relief is punishable by a criminal contempt action, with a penalty of six months in jail and/or a fine not exceeding \$1000) and attorney's fees

The American Resistance Party is a different party than the Republican Party. However, an attack on one party is an attack on ALL PARTIES. It must cease!
