The hanging of an effigy IS NOT protected by the Constitution! This is merely a "questionable interpretation" by our courts.

Indiana Constitution (hanging effigy not implied!)

The Declaration of Rights as found in the Indiana Constitution state:

"Section 9. No law shall be passed, restraining the free interchange of thought and opinion, or restricting the **right to speak, write, or print, freely**, on any subject whatever: **but for the abuse of that right, every person shall be responsible.**"

US Constitution (hanging effigy not implied!)

Amendment 1 - Freedom of Religion, Press, Expression. Ratified 12/15/1791.

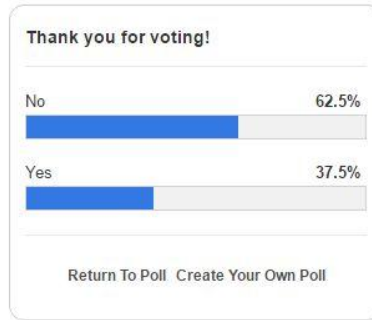
Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, **or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech**

However, the US Constitution does forbid actions which are defined as "insurrection". **INSURRECTION is defined as:** "1. an act or instance of rising in revolt, rebellion, or resistance against civil authority or an established government."

The **poll** (left) shows that most people (2:1) believe hanging an effigy borders on "insurrection" and is "illegal".
