17 **Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead**, being alone.

So why would an American Citizen need to be a Christian and believe AND DO GOOD WORKS? It is very simple, BECAUSE THE CONSTITUTION (and Bible) SAYS SO!!

California Preamble

"We, the People of the State of California, grateful to Almighty God for our freedom, in order to secure and perpetuate its blessings, do establish this Constitution."

Pennsylvania Preamble

"We, the people of Pennsylvania, grateful to Almighty God for the blessings of civil and religious liberty, and humbly invoking His guidance..."

The U.S. Constitution is a little bit different. It acknowledges our Lord and master AT THE END of the document when it states: *"Done in Convention by the Unanimous Consent of the States present the **Seventeenth Day of September in the Year of our Lord** one thousand seven hundred and Eighty seven..."*

And even the Preamble imply divine providence when it says, *"...secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the United States of America."* **Blessings of Liberty can only come from a Divine being.**

...ELSE EACH STATE CONSTITUTION WOULD BE ABSOLUTELY MEANINGLESS!

Why did JESUS go to the synagogue?

The synagogue was his Jewish place of worship, but was also used as a place to study, teach and often as a community center as well. Today, Orthodox Jews often use the

Yiddish word shul (pronounced shool) to refer to their synagogue. In the USA, synagogues are often called temples. Ancient Christians were often in hiding, so “Christian churches” were secret places where fellow Christians met, but once the persecution of Christians ended, they began their own “churches” (aka Catholic/Protestant denominations).

The early Christians were exhorted to GO TO CHURCH!

Hebrews 10:

25 **Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together**, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

Note:

[Hebrews 10:25](#). Μὴ ἐγκαταλείποντες τὴν ἐπισυναγωγὴν ἑαυτῶν, καθὼς ἔθος τισίν] *while not forsaking* (ceasing to frequent), *as is the custom with some, our own assembly*, and thereby, in connection with the already prevalent tendency to apostasy from Christianity, setting a pernicious example.

In other words, not going to church is a form of apostasy!

- an addition (to the Constitution)

5. What do we call the first ten amendments to the Constitution?

- the Bill of Rights

6. What is one right or freedom from the First Amendment?*

- speech
- religion
- assembly
- press
- petition the government

7. How many amendments does the Constitution have?

- twenty-seven (27)

8. What did the Declaration of Independence do?

- announced our independence (from Great Britain)
- declared our independence (from Great Britain)
- said that the United States is free (from Great Britain)

9. What are two rights in the Declaration of Independence?

- life
- liberty
- pursuit of happiness

All people are by nature free and independent and have inalienable rights. **Among these are** enjoying and defending life and liberty, **acquiring, possessing, and protecting property**, and pursuing and obtaining safety, happiness, and privacy.) (That is what CAPITALISM IS!)
- market economy
