
**AIN'T GOING TO SUNDAY SCHOOL?

## **RESPONSE by Edward C Noonan, founder of the [American Resistance Party](#):**

This falls into my "**if you ain't going to Sunday School, you ain't constitutional**" Sermonette #1!

There are only two kinds of people in the United States. And they are NOT Dem and Reps, or left or right... There are only CONSTITUTIONALISTS and all others.

Constitutionalist are "Christians" that attend Sunday School regularly!

To be a Christian, you must know the fundamentals of the Constitution. Where is evolved from and especially how it applies to citizens of our great country.

The foundation of our country, of course, was the Declaration of Independence. The beginning words include, "*We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness...*"

These words inspired our Constitution, which ends with the words (in the signature block), "*Done in Convention by the Unanimous Consent of the States present the Seventeenth Day of September in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty seven and of the Independence of the United States of America the Twelfth.*"

OUR LORD, as mentioned here in the US Constitution, of course is our LORD JESUS CHRIST! And our dating system counts the number of years since the birth of our Lord. (In this case, 1787).

Thereafter, each state mentions this homage to our Creator and his son. Here in California the CA Constitution states, "PREAMBLE - We, the People of the State of California, grateful to Almighty God for our freedom, in order to secure and perpetuate its blessings, do establish this Constitution."

All states have such words of gratefulness... for instance the 1780 State Constitution of Massachusetts state in their Preamble, "*...We, therefore, the people of Massachusetts, acknowledging, with grateful hearts, the goodness of the Great Legislator of the Universe, in affording us, in the course of His providence, an opportunity, deliberately and peaceably, without fraud, violence or surprise, of entering into an original, explicit, and solemn compact with each other; and of forming a new Constitution of Civil Government, for ourselves and posterity; and devoutly imploring His direction in so interesting a design, DO agree upon, ordain and establish, the following Declaration of Rights, and Frame of Government, as the CONSTITUTION of the COMMONWEALTH of MASSACHUSETTS.*" [end quote]

And then their 2nd Declaration of Rights of the Inhabitants of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts state, "*Art II.--It is the right as well as the duty of all men in society, publicly, and at stated seasons, to worship the SUPREME BEING, the great creator and preserver of the universe. And no subject shall be hurt, molested, or restrained, in [Volume 1, Page 12] his person, liberty, or estate, for worshipping GOD in the manner and season most agreeable to the dictates of his own conscience; or for his religious profession or sentiments; provided he doth not disturb the public peace, or obstruct others in their religious worship.*" [end quote]

It is therefore a Constitutional requirement that all citizens have a duty to worship the SUPREME BEING. Most citizens go to SUNDAY SCHOOL to learn of our Almighty and his son, Jesus Christ. It is clearly a Constitutional mandate to do so. Hence:
